

GLOSSARY

- Annual:** A plant living and growing for only one year.
- Commodity:** An agricultural product.
- Crown:** This is the thick area in the center of the plant.
- Daughter plants** The rooted plants from the runners.
- Everbearing:** A strawberry plant that bears fruit twice 'in one season; once in the spring and later in the fall.
- Hybrid:** The offspring of genetically dissimilar parents. i.e. Plants that are of different varieties. Something of mixed origin or composition.
- Junebearing:** A strawberry plant that bears fruit only once in a season; it produces fruit in the early summer.
- Mother plants:** The original plant put in the ground This is the plant that sends out the runners.
- Mulch:** A protective covering, as of straw or hay, placed around plants to prevent evaporation of moisture and freezing of roots and to control weeds.
- Perennial:** A plant lasting for a number of years.
- Runners:** A creeping stem that roots at intervals along its length.
